Efficiency of treatment in the dental patient today: a step beyond effectiveness

- Ideal requisites of an efficient treatment protocol in orthodontics and dentofacial orthopedics
- The goal: to identify, learn, and apply factors of success

Orthodontics, periodontology, implantology, and oral surgery: 4 interdisciplinary fields

- The biology of the tooth-periodontal unit
- Ortho-perio aspects of tooth eruption and tooth alignment

How to increase success in severe dentoskeletal disharmonies

- The greatest challenges in orthodontics: Class III malocclusion and vertical disharmonies
- Aspects of difficulty in treatment planning
- The role of timing in improving success of dentofacial orthopedics
- The use of microimplants in dentofacial orthopedics
- Relationships between surgery and orthodontics in severe malocclusions

Periodontal and surgical procedures in the orthodontic patient

Preventive mucogingival surgery

- Surgical approach to impacted teeth (the impacted canine)
- Tooth displacement and tooth impaction.
- Possibilities of interceptive orthodontic treatment: results of RCTs
- When the canine is impacted: the correct surgical-orthodontic approach
- The tunnel technique for upper or lower impacted canines
- Periodontal outcomes in the long term

Interceptive mucogingival surgery

- Periodontal concerns of teeth erupting buccally
- Surgical approaches to save the gingival tissues in teeth erupting buccally
- Selection of the periodontal surgical approach depending on the tooth position

Orthodontics to recreate periodontal tissues

- The use of orthodontic movements to improve the gingival lines. Esthetic rules
- Tooth extrusion to recreate periodontal tissues for implant or restorative dentistry
- Microimplants as an aid in complex clinical conditions

How to avoid periodontal problems in orthodontics

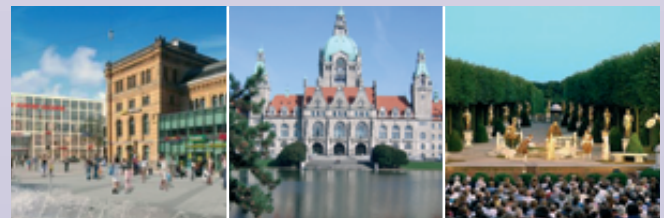
- Orthodontic and orthopedic forces: risk for root resorption and periodontal recession
- Timing of treatment: its role on periodontal damage
- The "envelope" of orthodontic movements allowed by the periodontal tissues

The orthodontic treatment of patients treated for periodontal problems

- The severely compromised periodontal patient
- What can orthodontics do to improve the occlusion and the esthetics of these patients?
- Rational for a reasonable orthodontic treatment of periodontally-compromised patients
- Occlusal and esthetic results in the long term

Esthetic considerations in the perspective of the ageing face and dentition

- Physiological changes in the occlusion, profile, and smile due to the ageing process
- How to finish orthodontic cases in order to contrast the effect of ageing.
